Delivery Policy

As to goods delivered by CMG's truck, ownership passes upon delivery at the place Buyer receives possession, and thereafter, all risk of loss or damage shall be on Buyer. Deliveries by common carrier are F.O.B. shipping point. On direct shipments from manufacturers, ownership passes to Buyer at point and time of delivery to carrier, and thereafter, all risk of loss or damage shall be on Buyer. Damage or shortage claims arising from direct shipments are to be made by Buyer against carrier. CMG assumes no responsibility beyond point of delivery to carrier in good order and is not responsible for loss, damage, or delay occurring thereafter.

Offloading and Handling

Buyer assumes all responsibility and subsequent liability for the proper handling and offloading of all goods in such a manner as to prevent against damage and/or loss. Buyer hereby acknowledges responsibility to provide proper and adequate means to offload, handle, hoist and transport all materials upon arrival at destination. This includes, but is not limited to, equipment, manpower and staging. Further, CMG shall assume no responsibility or liability for damages and/or loss resulting from inadequate handling of materials subsequent to delivery at the point of sale.

Special note regarding long materials:

CMG routinely manufactures fabricated items that are, at the request of the customer, provided in long lengths. These items may include, but are not limited to, standing seam roofing panels, wall panels, soffit panels and seamless formed gutter sections as well as other formed shapes. Long sections are defined as any part exceeding 8'-0" in length. It is expressly understood by way of this agreement that it is the sole responsibility of the Buyer to provide adequate manpower, equipment and staging to properly offload, handle, hoist and transport these items. Specifically, long products must be supported using multiple forklifts, spreader bars or other such provision to adequately spread and support the load over the length of the formed parts in order to prevent and avoid damage. Damage and loss can be expected when handling long parts using single point hoisting. CMG shall assume no responsibility or liability for damages and/or loss resulting from inadequate handling of materials in such a manner. By execution of this agreement, Buyer hereby assumes all responsibility for proper material handling and accepts any and all liability for damage or loss resulting from improper handling.
