S-5-Q Clamp

The S-5-Q clamp was specifically developed to accommodate metal roof panels having a large, round “bulb” seam configuration up to 29 mm. It will also fit smaller bulb-shaped profiles that were not seamed correctly, allowing the seam to be utilized without modification.


The clamp's two-piece design allows it to be easily installed anywhere along the length of the rib, making installation a snap! Just place the clamp on the seam, position the insert piece, and tighten the setscrews. Go to www.S-5.com/tools for information about properly attaching S-5![®] clamps.

After the clamp is installed, affix ancillary items using the top bolt provided. The S-5-Q is perfect for use with S-5! ColorGard[®] snow retention system and other heavy-duty applications.

S-5-Q Mini Clamp

The S-5-Q Mini is a bit shorter than the S-5-Q and has one setscrew rather than two. The mini is the choice for attaching all kinds of rooftop accessories: signs, walkways, satellite dishes, antennas, rooftop lighting, lightning protection systems, solar arrays, exhaust stack bracing, conduit, condensate lines, mechanical equipment—just about anything!*




The S-5-Q and S-5-Q Mini clamps are each furnished with the hardware shown to the right. Each box also includes a bit tip for tightening setscrews using an electric screw gun. The structural 6000 series aluminum attachment clamp is compatible with most common metal roofing materials excluding copper. All included hardware 3000 series is stainless steel. 
Example Profiles

Clamp setscrew tension should be verified using a calibrated torque wrench between 160 and 180 inch pounds when used on 22ga steel, and between 130 and 150 inch pounds for all other metals and thinner gauges of steel.
